Walking, especially with a group,
is a good form of exercise and
an excellent way to stay healthy.

Our walks are a mix of exercise, a picnic,
socialising, and fresh air
(and occasionally a little rain or mud).

If you decide to walk with us, we advise that you
bring suitable, robust footwear such as walking
boots or shoes. Waterproofs and a change of
footwear is recommended.

The walks are fairly easy, around 6 miles long
at a moderate pace, and suitable for most
people. Uphill sections do occur but they are
usually steady inclines and not too steep. You
ascend at your own pace and we make sure
that no-one gets left behind.

We have a refreshment break either en-route or
at the start of the walk. If you are walking with
us you will need to bring some sort of packed
lunch and a drink for the lunchtime stop.

If you want to walk ahead of the leader on the
walks, please ask their permission to do so.

***If you don't want to do the planned walk
with the group but would like to explore the
area on your own, you are welcome to join
us on the coach for the same price.***

Coach outings are generally run between
February and November.

Mid-week outings are by members' own cars,
and car sharing is encouraged.

Lectures are held from September to March,
on the 2nd Wednesday in each month,
at Forest Gate Baptist Church,
off Whitegate Drive Blackpool,
starting at 7.15 pm.

Entrance is £2.50 unless stated otherwise
(includes tea/coffee and biscuits).

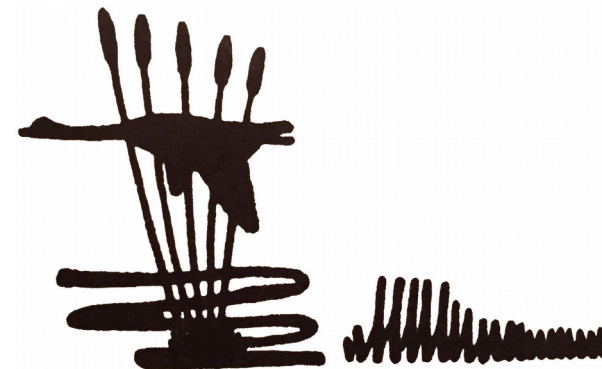
